Dear Parents and Carers,

Parking and Driving Carefully

As school and community we are highly disappointed to have to again remind the small number of you who persist in driving, parking and behaving inappropriately. It is unacceptable to drive dangerously and also to drive along pavements, parking on the yellow zig zag lines and speeding with no care or consideration. The **police and our legal team** have been made aware of this and the police will be around site regularly. Parents and carers can report these to the police with any photographic evidence which I am aware you are doing; thank you for your support.

We must keep our school site and local community safe for all.

You must do these things to help:

- Drive cautiously and considerately
- Use the car park at King George's playing fields
- Be considerate of our neighbours
- Park away from zig-zag lines
- Park away from school and park gate entrances
- Do not enter onto the school site with your vehicle, unless approved to do so – including Early Birds, Night Owls and other after school clubs
- Walk to school
- Drive extra carefully on roads near school – do not speed
- Ensure children are seat belted aware of correct legal seat requirements.

Appropriate Adult Behaviour on School Site and in our Community

In partnership with Flint Bishop Solicitors and the police, we remind you that you ***must behave in a way that is appropriate in public and our school site***. We expect parents and carers to demonstrate model behaviour to all in our community. Anyone that fails to meet the rules onsite and in the local area will be banned from site due to the safeguarding of children, staff and other parents.
